Yucca is located about 35 miles north of Lake Havsu City, AZ; 24 miles southwest of Kingman, AZ; and 38 miles east of Needles, CA. Lake Havasu mall shopping (Walmart, JcPenney, Dillards, movie theater, banking) is 25 minutes away. The town of Yucca has two Fire Stations, a Post Office and Kohinoor Dhaba Indian Food restaurant. The third best fishing hole in the State, Lake Alamo, is within an hour away. The climate of Yucca is fairly moderate all year long with mild winter temperatures and cooler summers compared to other parts of the state. Summer temperatures may reach in the lower 100s.

LAKE HAVASU CITY, AZ

Lake Havasu (a Native American word meaning blue water), a 45-mile long artificial lake created by Parker Dam on the Colorado River, is called the personal watercraft capital of the world. Many national and international events, including the annual World Racing Finals, take place here. One famous tourist attraction is the London Bridge. The bridge was dedicated on October 10, 1971 with 50,000 spectators attending the ceremony. Lake Havasu City hosts many festivals from the hot air balloon festival, to several classic car shows and music festivals throughout the year.

OATMAN, AZ

The town of Oatman is a historic gold mining town on Old Route 66, where you'll be greeted by burros standing in the middle of the street, happy to take handouts from the tourists. The main street of Oatman offers lots of character, lined with old western style wood-fron shops, hotels and old-time saloons. More than 500,000 visitors are drawn annually to Oatman's gold mine history, as well as the legend of its namesake. Olive Oatman is entrenched in the western lore as a woman who was kidnapped by an Indian tribe, then sold to a friendly local tribe before being freed to her family near what would become Oatman.




KINGMAN, AZ • GRAND CANYON WEST
